Arbitration is a formal dispute resolution process in which two or more parties refer their dispute to an independent third person who makes a binding decision.

New legal processes are often slow to take root and many attendees at the AIFLAM Arbitration Forums held around the country have raised questions about what precisely is required of practitioners wishing to embrace arbitration as a viable form of dispute resolution.
